

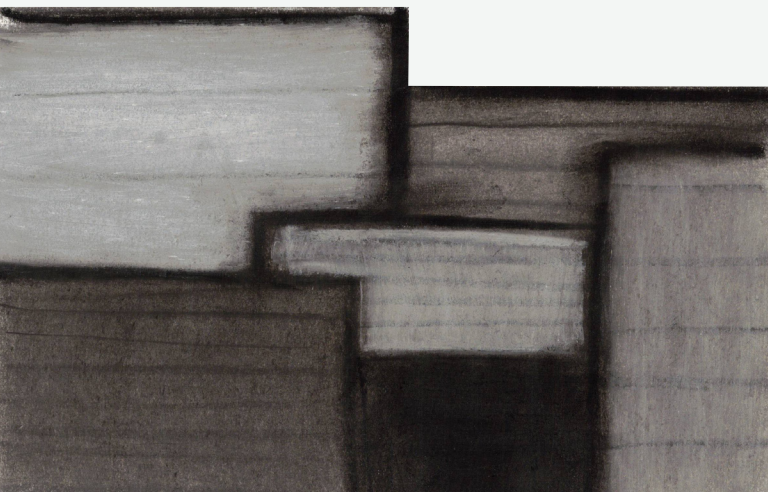

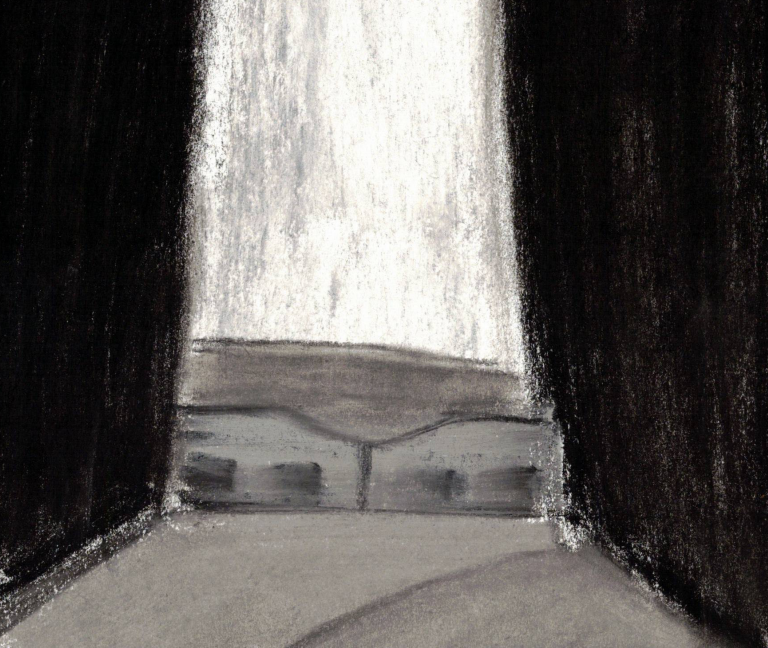
Sketching Toronto

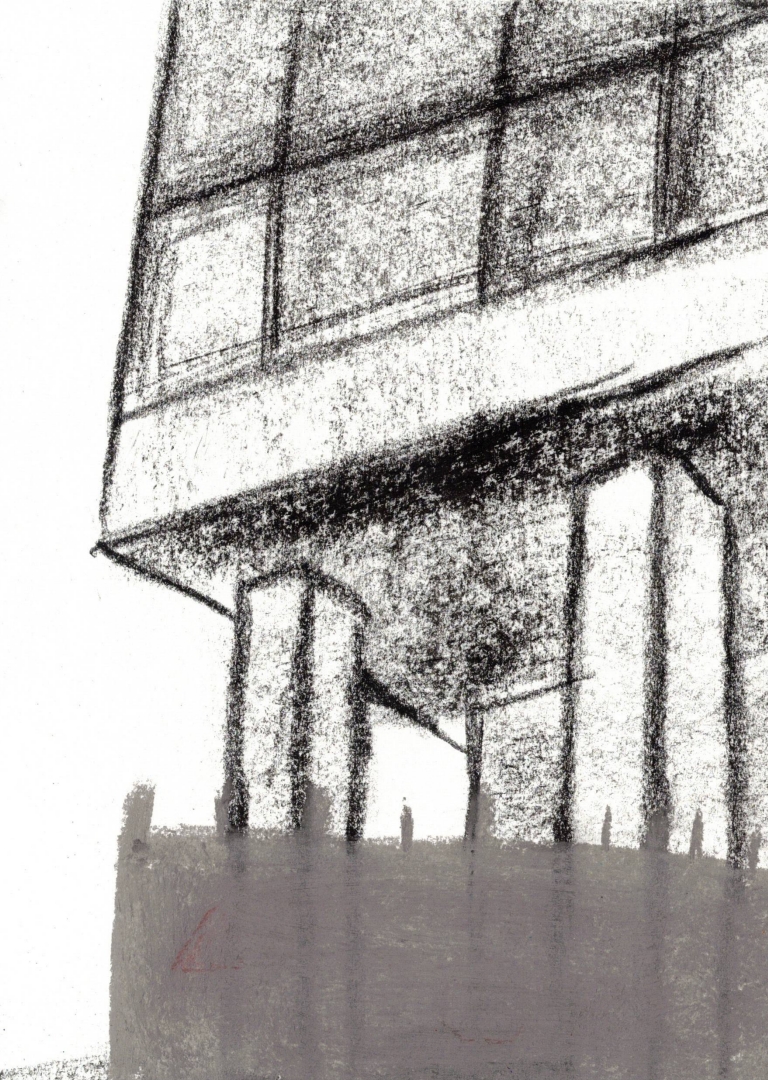
