

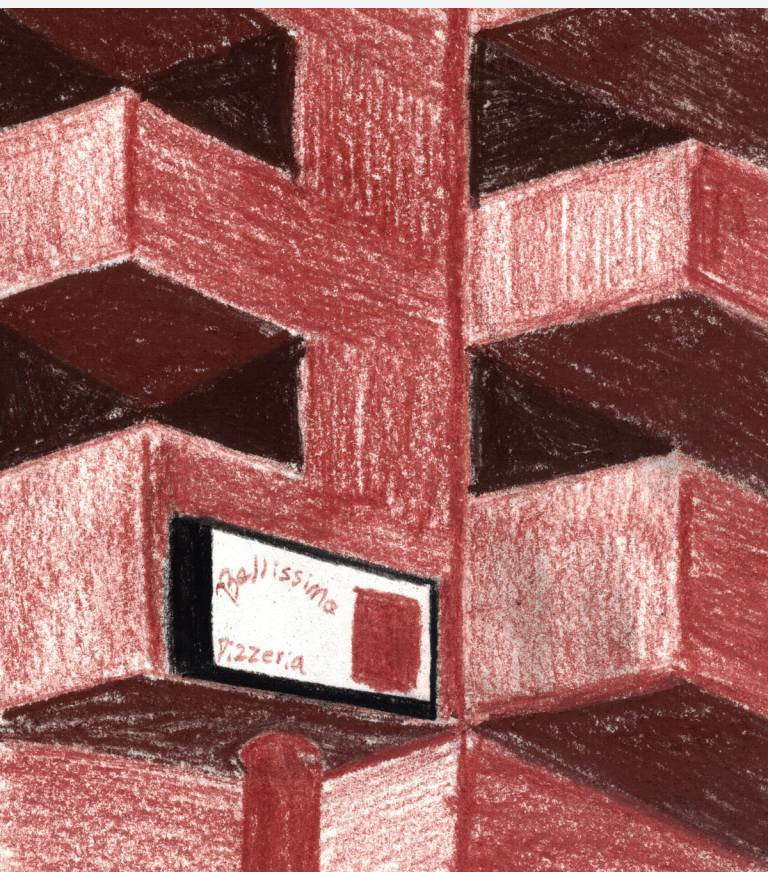
The Esplanade
